- Open to both RAILS and IHLS members.



What is eRead Illinois Axis 360?

- Shared e-content collection
- Over 50,000 e-books and audiobooks
- Membership includes all types of libraries
 - 254 public libraries
 - 234 school libraries
 - 28 academic and special libraries
- Open to RAILS libraries and IHLS libraries that are not part of SHARE




How do users access the content?

- Axis 360 website or app
- Compatible with most devices
- Follett Destiny integration
- Circulation of materials:
 - One book one user
 - Users can have up to 5 items checked out, 14 day loan period
 - Users can have up to 5 items on holds
 - We keep a low holds ratio to reduce wait times!



What's in the collection?

- Popular materials collection
- CARES Grant: \$125,000 for K-12 materials
- Can I limit the content students can access?
 - Yes! You can scope the collection to your specific audience.
- Can I add more content?
 - Yes! The Unbound program allows you to purchase materials just for your users.



How much does it cost?

- Annual membership fee
 - \$250 base fee + population fee + .5% collection budget
- Join as a district or as a building
- Annual renewal

- E-content collection
- Over 44,000 items, e-books, images, video clips, and more.
- Freely available to everyone in Illinois via RAILS
- Unique collection
 - Small presses and independent publishers
 - Materials in the public domain
 - Self-published content, etc.

- Collection highlights:
 - Publishers: ABDO, Capstone, Time for Kids, etc.
 - Recovering the Classics
 - BiblioBoard Core
 - Content in Spanish
- Can I limit what my students can access?
 - Sort of! The RAILS for Schools collection is limited to educational materials










The BiblioBoard Library: Access

- BiblioBoard website or app
 - Available for iOS and Android
- No library card necessary
 - Login is optional
- Simultaneous use
 - No holds, no waits
 - Everything is available to everyone all the time




