- Inaccurate data












HTC maps only mark below average

Ideas for outreach in an 'Easy To Count' community

- Folks from outside your area who work in or do business in your community
 - Waiting room slideshows at the doctor or the DMV
 - Roadside banners
 - Encourage local businesses to talk about it with their employees
- Turn your residents into Census Ambassadors
 - Social media messaging opportunities
 - Postcard campaign



- Count All Kids specific strategies for counting young children
 - People overlook them because "they are just children"
 - Complicated households
 - "You can fill it out on your own time and it only takes 10 minutes"
 - Privacy guarantee
 - Schools will get more funding
 - Only happens every 10 years, so if you miss your 2-year-old, they'll be 12 before you can fix it
