*Please, no seating on the floor.

At the Kankakee Public Library our focus is to keep our patrons and our employees safe. Beginning Tuesday, March 17 the Library will be moving to Walk-In Services Only as a preventative measure to minimize the possible spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19) through social distancing.

The following services will be available only:

- Checking out books
- Picking up holds
- Copying/Scanning/Printing
- Faxing
- Notary services
- Public computer use for 10 minutes or less
- Reference and obituary requests (please call or email first)

All programming and meeting room use has been discontinued until further notice.

We are closely following CDC (Center for Disease Control) guidelines and monitoring the situation as it progresses.
