ABOUT: RAILS service and operations report—August 2017

Major sections in this report correspond to the goals in the RAILS strategic plan (https://www.railslibraries.info/about/strategic-plan).

Resource Sharing

Delivery

- RAILS is still waiting for the delivery study proposal from LASA (the Laboratory for Applied Spatial Analysis at Southern Illinois University Edwardsville) to work its way through the university's process. In the meantime, RAILS staff is working on supplying LASA with the data it will need (delivery volumes, delivery stops, hub locations, etc.).
- The Illinois State Library, Illinois Heartland Library System, and RAILS have agreed on the FY2018 dates for the quarterly delivery fine counts:
 - o September 11–15, 2017
 - o November 13–17, 2017
 - o February 19–23, 2018
 - o May 14–18, 2018

During these weeks, libraries will be asked to count items being put into the delivery bins. This methodology provides standardized samples for determining delivery volumes.

E-book Projects

- Veronda Pitchford presented on RAILS e-content strategy and RAILS e-book projects at the RSA Back to School event on August 8 in East Peoria.

Group Purchases and Discounts

- On July 24, RAILS Resource Sharing staff negotiated and implemented a discount of at least 12% off retail price for RAILS members for Quill.com products. Quill.com sells office supplies, furniture, and cleaning products.
- On August 6 in Bolingbrook, Veronda Pitchford attended the Fountaindale Public Library District
 graduation ceremony for the nine graduates in the second class of the Gale Cengage Career Online High
 School (COHS). To make the COHS program affordable for Illinois libraries, RAILS financially supports the
 student assessment portal for potential participants.

LLSAPs and Other Consortia

- At the Consortia Committee meeting on July 24, Jane Plass asked committee members to submit their questions about the overlay project in writing. A number of questions were received; these will be used as a basis for developing an informational document (FAQ).
- On July 26, Jane Plass spoke about the overlay project at PrairieCat's Delegates Assembly.

Access to Information

Illinois Talking Book Outreach Center

- On August 9, Dee Brennan, Rose Chenoweth, and Jane Plass spoke with Greg McCormick and Sharon Ruda at the Illinois State Library via conference call. The discussion focused on ensuring a smooth transition of ITBOC services to the Illinois State Library Talking Book and Braille Service (ISLTBBS).
 Although the full cutover date is September 1, ISLTBBS staff are already handling some calls that ITBOC staff would have previously handled.
- ITBOC staff are finishing work needed for the transition, including work on cleaning up the talking book database.
- On August 11, ITBOC staff in Burr Ridge and East Peoria met at Burr Ridge for their last in-person meeting and an opportunity to say farewell to one another and to other RAILS staff.

Unserved and Underserved

• The Illinois State Library held a second discussion on the unserved issue on August 17. RAILS staff attending in Springfield or by videoconferencing included Dee Brennan, Jim Kregor, Amanda Musacchio, Veronda Pitchford, Jane Plass, and Mary Witt.

Member Engagement

Communications

- Debbie Baaske and Brian Smith staffed the RAILS table at the August 11 SWANstravaganza at Moraine
 Valley Community College in Palos Hills. Approximately 143 RAILS members who are also members of
 the SWAN consortium stopped by to hear the latest RAILS news and to spin the "RAILS or SWAN" prize
 wheel. There is often confusion about which services RAILS provides vs. which services RAILS LLSAPs
 provide. This was the perfect opportunity to clear up some of that confusion.
- In response to numerous member requests, Brian Smith created a library policy/procedures/plans repository and a job description repository for members to share their documents and to view offerings from other libraries in various categories. RAILS will seek member feedback and make the repositories available in the Members/Surveys & Sharing section of the RAILS website.

• RAILS will once again offer these collaborative grants in FY2018. There will be two grant periods with application deadlines of November 17, 2017 and April 20, 2018.

Networking Events

- RAILS will cohost a networking and CE event with Literacy DuPage on September 6 at 9:30 a.m. at
 Wheaton Public Library. Public and school libraries in DuPage county are encouraged to attend to learn
 about ways they can partner with Literacy DuPage.
- RAILS will host a networking event at Engineering Systems, Incorporated in Aurora on September 7 at 1:00 p.m. Cheryl Hansen, Research Librarian, will give a tour of the library and will talk about the services and resources that are provided to employees through the library. Debbie Baaske will share the latest RAILS news and will answer questions. All members from all types of libraries are invited.

Continuing Education and Consulting Services

Continuing Education

- See the attached report for statistics on recent RAILS continuing education events.
- The FY2018 public library per capita grant application includes a training requirement that "staff and trustees will complete at least one free online educational opportunity focusing on safety in the Library." (Full details on this requirement will be made available with the application in early October.) In response to member inquiries, RAILS will offer training opportunities on this topic in September and again in early 2018. RAILS has confirmed with Illinois State Library staff that recorded, archived learning opportunities will also count towards this requirement.
- RAILS is pleased to again offer CE networking group grants during FY2018. In FY2017, RAILS awarded over \$23,000 in support of 13 CE events throughout the RAILS area. There will be five grant periods during FY2018. The first application deadline is September 30, 2017.
- Upcoming CE opportunities include a Management Association webinar on HR documentation on August 22, a two-part webinar series on disaster preparedness the week of September 11, and a twopart webinar series on library security on September 13 and 20.

Consulting

• The FOIA hotline was made available to RAILS and IHLS members in May 2016. Since then, it has been used 56 times, with 48 of those inquiries from RAILS member libraries. RAILS is currently exploring the expansion of the FOIA hotline to include Open Meetings Act inquiries. The hotline has received OMA questions several times over the past year, so this expansion would help satisfy another informational need for libraries. Ancel Glink is currently working on a revised agreement for RAILS review. This enhanced service could begin as early as October 1.

Leadership and Innovation

• Jim Kregor, as Treasurer of both Library Insurance Management & Risk Control Combination (LIMRICC) and Libraries of Illinois Risk Agency (LIRA) attended a board meeting and Executive Committee Strategic Planning meetings on August 15 and August 18, respectively.

Organizational Excellence

Human Resources

- RAILS had no new hires and one termination (Patrick Pletcher, Driver) since the July operations report.
 (Terminations refer to all persons leaving RAILS employment for any reason, including resignations and retirements.)
- HR is working to fill one open driver position at the Bolingbrook facility.

• HR is working to ensure a smooth separation process for the ITBOC staff, as ITBOC operations will cease on August 31.

Information Technology

- RAILS IT staff have finished cabling the jacks in the main meeting room floor. Electrical outlets were also added as part of the renovation. These changes will allow easy Internet and power access while eliminating tripping hazards from cables going to wall outlets.
- Several RAILS IT staff attended Defcon, one of the largest security conferences in the world, from July 27–30 to learn more about keeping the RAILS network and information safe.
- The Bolingbrook service center lost phone and Internet service on Friday afternoon, August 11. RAILS IT staff worked with AT&T and the Illinois Century Network (ICN) to determine that the fiber optic cable serving the Bolingbrook location was cut by construction in the area. AT&T resolved the problem by 3:30 a.m. on Saturday, August 12, and RAILS IT staff tested the connection.
- RAILS IT staff continue to work with PrairieCat staff on PrairieCat's transition from servers at the Burr Ridge office to servers hosted by Innovative Interfaces.

Stewardship

Administration and Finance

• The Finance staff worked with the auditors for RAILS, MAGIC, PrairieCat, and SWAN during August. All audits are proceeding very well.

Facilities

The Burr Ridge renovation project continues to run smoothly except for some delays in receiving
materials. The carpet installation and painting to remove the green trim is complete. Staff are assessing
work spaces for damage or installation problems to create a punch list for the construction manager
from Bulley & Andrews to address. Because of the material delays, the timeline for project completion
has changed to mid-September as the worst case scenario. As a precaution, meeting space will continue
to be unavailable until October 2017.
