Strengths: The Poetry Foundation mission is to promote a wider readership for poetry with the general public. The physical library has a great advantage for visitors to the space as it is front and center when first entering the building as a public resource of the organization. The staffed information desk in the library is available for visitors to seek poetry recommendations to read whilst visiting from the non-circulating collection. The library director also participates in the curation of exhibits, Poetry Time in the library for small children and partners with local hospitals in a poetry for patients program for those in hospice.

Challenges: The library is very interested in expanding partnerships to suburban libraries to support these libraries in developing poetry programming. The Poetry Foundation Library is open to the public and they have a fair number of visitors there for casual poetry reading. However the hours are not as compatible for those who cannot visit during traditional business hours or their limited weekend hours.
