- 1. Continue to implement the goals and objectives of the strategic plan.

- Ensure financial sustainability for RAILS by finding efficiencies and cost savings, streamlining processes and procedures, and setting service priorities that still serve all RAILS members.
- 4. Lead discussion of LLSAP funding changes based on need for sustainability, equity and stewardship.
- 5. Support development and implementation of ILL/resource sharing overlay.
- 6. Implement ExploreMoreIllinois.org program
- 7. Develop RAILS expertise in Design Thinking methodology
- 8. Develop long term plan to consolidate buildings and delivery hubs (continuation)
- 9. Encourage resource sharing and cooperation among different types of libraries
- 10. Measure the importance and impact of RAILS services.
- 11. Communicate with board members so board members can make timely, informed decisions.

- 1. Complete system membership standards work
- 2. Develop a plan with options to serve the unserved
- 3. Continue to work on goals of the strategic plan
- 4. Encourage patron-centered re-alignment/merger/consolidation of LLSAPs and consortia
- 5. Develop more services for non-public libraries and enhance the role of academic and special libraries in RAILS
- 6. Offer grants for multi-type collaborative projects to encourage resource sharing and cooperation among different types of libraries

- 7. Identify ways to measure the impact of RAILS services
- 8. Develop a transition plan for ITBOC services in FY 2018 in collaboration with the ISL
- 9. Develop a long term plan for further delivery outsourcing and reduction of our physical footprint
- 10. Ensure effective orientation of new board members and that ongoing communication with all board members provides all necessary information for the board to make timely, informed decisions

I have included last year's goals so that if there are any that should be continued we can add them. In some cases, such as with the multi-type collaborative grants, goals have been operationalized and included in our annual plan of service.
