Re: Illinois Community College Library Service to District Residents

In 2017, staff from RAILS, Illinois Heartland Library System (IHLS), and the Illinois State Library (ISL) met several times to discuss the unserved issue (i.e. Illinois residents without any public library service). During these discussions, it was decided that RAILS and IHLS would survey Illinois community colleges about their library services to nonstudent residents in their districts. Since July 1990, the entire state has been included within community college district boundaries.

The Illinois Community College Library Service to District Residents Survey was emailed to all Illinois community college libraries on November 27, 2017, with responses requested by December 4, 2017. This document includes the summary of the survey.

100% of respondents reported that their community college library allows district residents to use the library, and 91% allow district residents to check out books. 35% of respondents allow district residents to use assistive services. 26% of respondents allow district residents to request interlibrary loan materials.
