ABOUT: Disposal of Surplus Vehicles

Attached is a list of RAILS delivery vehicles that have been, or soon will be, removed from service. After thorough inspections of each vehicle by certified mechanics, RAILS staff have determined that these vehicles should no longer be used because they are unsafe, unreliable, no longer running, and/or too expensive to repair.

Normally, surplus property is offered to the Illinois State Library and Illinois Heartland Library System, followed by an offering to member libraries through an online auction. However, these vehicles are in such poor condition that their only value is as scrap metal. We ask that the Board approve disposal of the vehicles on the attached list to a local scrap metal firm.

In September, RAILS received four Ford Transit cargo vans as replacements for these delivery vehicles, with an additional four box trucks on order.
