ABOUT: Community Colleges and the Unserved

At the June 11, 2018 meeting of the Resource Sharing Committee, we began a discussion of community colleges and the unserved. Ashtin Trimble (Director of Library Services at Black Hawk College) and Terra Jacobson (Dean, Learning Resource Center/Library at Moraine Valley Community College) are both planning to attend the committee's meeting on September 10 so that we can continue the discussion.

Some discussion-starter questions:

- What challenges do community college libraries face in providing services to those who reside in their community college district but are not students?
- Are such services limited to cardholders from a public library (e.g. reciprocal borrowing), or are services also available to community college district residents without public library service?
- Are such services to nonstudents in the district publicized? If so, how?
- How can we (systems, the Illinois State Library, and libraries) cooperate to reach the unserved? What are some next steps?

The June meeting packet included a memo with results of a 2017 survey of community college libraries. That memo is attached for your convenience.

Re: Illinois Community College Library Service to District Residents

In 2017, staff from RAILS, Illinois Heartland Library System (IHLS), and the Illinois State Library (ISL) met several times to discuss the unserved issue (i.e. Illinois residents without any public library service). During these discussions, it was decided that RAILS and IHLS would survey Illinois community colleges about their library services to nonstudent residents in their districts. Since July 1990, the entire state has been included within community college district boundaries.

The Illinois Community College Library Service to District Residents Survey was emailed to all Illinois community college libraries on November 27, 2017, with responses requested by December 4, 2017. This document includes the summary of the survey.

100% of respondents reported that their community college library allows district residents to use the library, and 91% allow district residents to check out books. 35% of respondents allow district residents to use assistive services. 26% of respondents allow district residents to request interlibrary loan materials.
