Executive Director goals FY 2019 revised

- 1. Talk to member libraries to determine their most pressing needs and do what you can to help them fulfill those.
- 2. Work to better clarify both the upsides and the downsides of the Find More Illinois project. Open discussions are needed.
- 3. Continue consolidation of buildings and delivery hubs, striving for maximum efficiency and cost savings.
- 4. Improve upon the orientation process for new Board members.
- 5. Bring equity and inclusion to the LLSAP funding model. Make the details clear sooner rather than later.
- 6. Implement the new standards.
- 7. Continue to visit local libraries. The format of the strategic planning sessions "what keeps you up at night" was very well received.
- 8. Deliver continuing education sessions addressing issues suggested by RAILS libraries.
- 9. Implement new annual grant funding for LLSAPs and other eligible consortia.
- 10. Work on greater diversity of RAILS board. Perhaps we need to take a different action to ensure equity of representation, if the traditional elections are not accomplishing it.
- 11. Continue increased emphasis on serving libraries of all types. This could include more collaboration with CARLI and other groups that serve all types of libraries.
- 12. Implement LASA study recommendations and negotiate changes to ILDS contract.
- 13. Complete RAILS branding
- 14. Finalize new strategic plan.
