

## RAILS Member Engagement Report

February 2020

### Introduction

As a multitype library system, RAILS has a commitment to building relationships with all types of libraries (academic, public, school, and special). It is the responsibility of the Member Engagement Manager to plan, develop, and implement outreach programs and special events to enhance member engagement and increase participation in system programs and activities.

### Activities

In the past two years, RAILS has developed a series of six-month plans in order to determine needs and priorities for member engagement activities. Each six month plan includes a monthly list of preferred locations for site visits (organized by type and region).

#### In-person site visits

RAILS regularly visits member libraries to review programs and services and to answer questions about the system. Priority is typically given to libraries that have not been visited in the past three years.
