- Tied more closely to inkie.org

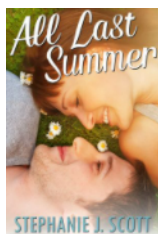


## INKIE.ORG

- A suite of self-publishing tools and resources
  - Pressbooks software to create e-book files
  - Pipeline for inclusion in the BiblioBoard/Inkie.org Library
- Available to everyone in Illinois at no cost, no library card required

- Updated the inkie.org website to connect it to the rebranded Inkie.org Library
- 245 e-books created via Pressbooks since October 2019



## EReAD ILLINOIS

- Popular materials collection hosted on Baker & Taylor's Axis 360 platform
- Membership: Academic: 23; Public: 251; School: 690 (buildings); Special: 6
- 57,000+ items, content added weekly
  - Low holds ratio
  - 100% of membership fees goes to the shared collection

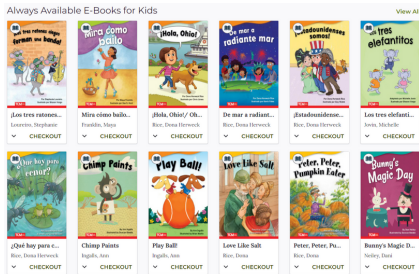

- Upcoming EDI audit of the collection



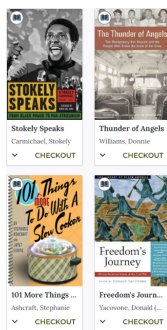
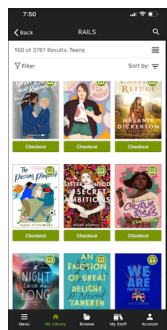

## ERead ILLINOIS CONTENT ADDITIONS



- 5,000+ titles transferred from the BiblioBoard Library to eRead Illinois Axis 360
  - Simultaneous use titles
  - Includes titles from ABDO, Capstone, Time for Kids, Recovering the Classics, Chicago Review Press, and more
  - Transfer started December 2021
- K-12 E-Content Grant
  - \$125,000 grant through the Illinois Office of the Secretary of State as part of the CARES Act (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act)
  - Purchasing ran from December 2020 - June 2021
  - 2,822 e-books and 934 audiobooks added



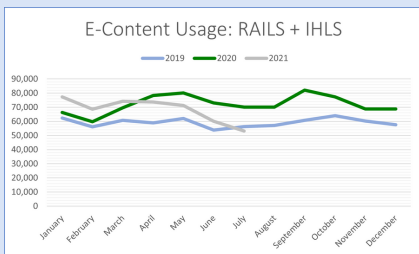
