Description

United CUSD 304 is a school district located in Monmouth, IL. There are four schools in the district, two elementary schools, a junior high school, and a high school. According to the Illinois State Board of Education, the district has an enrollment of 947 students. Approximately, 46% of students qualify as low income.

The district was previously part of RAILS. In late 2019, the school librarian left the district. RAILS tried to verify that the district had staffed libraries but did not receive a respond. The RAILS Board of Directors voted to suspend the district in January 2020.

Earlier this year, I spoke to Trish Bertelsen, who is now the Library/Technology Specialist for the district. She indicated that this situation in 2020 was ultimately a misunderstanding. The previous school librarian had left abruptly due to a medical situation. At the time, no one was able to take over her responsibilities and much of the work of the library went unaddressed. She assured me that all the libraries in the district are now staffed, and the district is eager to reinstate their system membership.
