The RAILS BIPOC Library Workers Group has been meeting bi-monthly to discuss a number of topics requested by members of the listserv. Some of the topics discussed are resources and recommendations for creating EDI committees at libraries that members are a part of, community outreach, MLIS/MLS requirements for certain positions, compensation and benefits, work environments, hiring and retention, and more.
