
- Welcome and Call to Order Gwen Gregory, Vice President of the RAILS Board, called the meeting to order at 10:31 a.m.
- 2. Roll Call of Committee Members

- 3. Recognition of Guests and Announcements

- 4. Public Comments
  There were no public comments.
- 5. Adoption of the Consent Agenda
  - 5.1. Adoption of the Agenda
  - 5.2. Approval of the RAILS Policy Committee Meeting Minutes December 15<sup>th,</sup> 2023. Hovanec moved for the approval of the consent agenda. Creason seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.
- 6. Unfinished Business
  - 6.1 Transitional Duty Policy Final Review

Harris presented the attorney clarification regarding the use of the phrase "medical practitioner" in the policy text. It is the same as the term used in the Illinois Workers' Compensation Act. After some discussion, the committee decided to add the definition of medical practitioner as defined in the Illinois Workers' Compensation Act to the text of the policy and vote to approve it for presentation to the full Board. Stagg moved for the approval, Creason seconded, and the policy was unanimously approved.

The committee raised a number of questions and proposed changes to the text of the policy. RAILS will consult with their attorney and report back to the committee.

The committee members suggested several changes, including the title of the policy. RAILS will edit the policy and present it back to the committee.

The committee suggested some edits and recommended that the IT department review the policy. It will re-assess the policy once the IT department completes its review.

RAILS will provide the committee with the version adopted by the Illinois Heartland Library System and our proposed version, maybe with clarified timelines.
