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# RAILS Report – Resource Sharing Committee

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## November RAILS Member Update

The [RAILS Member Update](#) was held on Wednesday, November 13, 2024. In addition to updates from RAILS, there was a discussion of artificial intelligence in libraries from Peter Musser (Institute of Knowledge Management in Education), an update about the ILA Legislative Meetups from Cyndi Robinson (ILA), and a presentation about First Amendment audits from Dustin Smaby (Vernon Area Public Library District).

## RAILS Premieres Find More Illinois Promo Video

Find More Illinois is an interlibrary loan platform with over 80 participating libraries. The platform currently provides participating libraries with access to over seven million items in one seamless interface. Libraries of all types and sizes are able to join the platform at any time during the year. To better understand how Find More Illinois impacts libraries and their communities, we visited seven participating libraries and asked them to reflect on their experiences with the interlibrary loan platform. We compiled these stories to create a [two-minute promotional video](#) that explores why they decided to join, what the setup process was like, and why other libraries in Illinois should consider joining.

## AISLE Annual Conference and AISLE Crystal Award

The AISLE Annual Conference was held on November 7-9 in Tinley Park. This year's theme is AISLE L.E.A.D.: Librarians – Educating, Advocating, Making a Difference. RAILS staff presented at a variety of sessions throughout the conference. Monica Harris was named the recipient of the Crystal Honor Award at this year's AISLE awards. This award is given for distinguished support of/or contributions to the school library profession, school libraries in Illinois, or contributions to the Association.

## ILDS Contract Discussion

Joe Filapek and Monica Harris met with colleagues from CARLI and IHLS to continue to discuss the ILDS contract on October 11. The next steps involve a draft of shared talking points explaining the increased costs of doing business with delivery as well as the rationale for a more 24 to 48-hour turnaround in support of greater efficiency and standardization.
