The product utilizes an accessibility enhancement tool (UserWay) in combination with native application code to support accessibility. Accessibility is an ongoing effort, and this report reflects a combination of automated evaluation, manual review, and known platform capabilities. Hiveclass is actively working toward continued alignment with WCAG 2.1 Level AA standards. Conformance results reflect a combination of automated testing (including accessibility tooling), manual review, and representative sampling of user flows, rather than exhaustive testing of all content and pages.
