Evaluation Methods Used: Manual evaluation using supported tools specific to browsers and operating systems in Chrome and Firefox for Windows and Safari for iOS. Screen reader testing using NVDA Windows and VoiceOver for iOS. Color contrast testing using Colour Contrast Analyzer. Additional automated testing support using aXe.
