- NewsAPI / JobsAPI – We display links and summaries from these services. Accessibility of the destination pages is managed by the respective providers, and we encourage them to follow WCAG standards wherever possible.
- HappyFox Chat – We provide a chat widget for user support. Accessibility of the chat interface is managed by HappyFox.

All other content on our platform, including marketing pages, privacy policy, and any images or links under our control, is fully accessible and WCAG compliant.

User support: If a user encounters accessibility barriers in any third-party component, our team is available to provide assistance and, if necessary, coordinate with the component provider to address the issue.
