**Product Description:** LibraryAware is a multi-channel promotional platform for libraries that includes readers' advisory materials, book recommendations, thousands of templates, and millions of images and graphics for promoting collections and programs.

### Notes:

Work to make LibraryAware's software accessible will be undertaken in the fall of 2026 with an accessibility audit to be conducted in early 2027.

Before Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act goes into effect in April 2027, LibraryAware's software will be made as accessible as possible to the ATAG 2.0 standard, and LibraryAware web outputs will be made accessible to the WCAG 2.1 AA standard.

The scope of the audit informing this report is limited to a point-in-time sample of representative web-based output and PDF documents generated by the LibraryAware platform. This report does not cover the accessibility of the authoring interface used to create or manage content. While the output was evaluated against WCAG 2.2 standards, the system's

performance as an authoring tool (specifically its ability to guide, encourage, or assist users in creating accessible content as defined by the Authoring Tool Accessibility Guidelines, ATAG 2.0) was not included in the scope of this evaluation.

The evaluated content samples included:

- Email newsletter samples in browser view formats (evaluated in browser only) representing output from all component types in both the Classic and Drag and Drop editor versions
- PDF samples representing output from all component types in both the Class and Drag and Drop editor versions
- Opt-in/Subscription management page
- Promotional widget carousel
- Embeddable widgets for:
  - Single book jacket
  - Multiple book jackets
  - Multiple book jackets with detail view
  - Newsletter single issue
  - Archive links

Unless explicitly stated otherwise within an individual criterion remark, all “Supports”, “Partially Supports”, or “Does Not Support” designations and accompanying explanations refer solely to samples of user-generated content within an end-user consumption experience.

**Evaluation Methods Used:** Manual evaluation using supported tools specific to browsers and operating systems in Chrome for Windows and Safari for iOS. PDFs were evaluated manually using Adobe Acrobat. Screen reader testing using NVDA Windows and VoiceOver for iOS. Color contrast testing using Colour Contrast Analyzer. Additional automated testing support using aXe and Acrobat Accessibility Checker.
