<u>RAILS Online Roundtables</u> are hour-long forums where library staff share best practices on a wide variety of topics.

Affordable Access to E-Resources

<u>eRead Illinois Axis 360</u> provides affordable access to nearly 65,000 e-books and audiobooks. Approximately 35% of items in the collection are aimed at children/young adults.

<u>Inkie.org</u> is a suite of resources available to everyone in Illinois at no charge courtesy of RAILS. Users can browse unique e-content collections from Illinois authors and libraries. Library patrons of all ages can design and self-publish their own e-books using Pressbooks software.

<u>Explore More Illinois</u>, RAILS online cultural and recreational pass program, features over 54 attractions of interest to library patrons of all ages. There is no charge for libraries to join.

<u>Find More Illinois</u> connects participating standalone and shared online catalogs. Library patrons can quickly search all these catalogs in a single search. The one-time setup fees are waived for libraries that join before the end of 2023! No annual fees will be billed until July 1, 2023.



<u>The World Language Cataloging Services</u> program provides original and copy cataloging for materials in world languages in a library's regular collection. This service is made possible by a grant from the Illinois State Library and there is no charge for libraries to use the service statewide.

RAILS offers a variety of <u>Deals and Discounts</u>, including group purchase offers, to help just about every library department save money.

Staff at all levels can play a role in promoting and advocating for their library and all libraries. The **My Library Is...** campaign provides talking points and other resources that can help.
